Listed Buildings in Shap and Shap Rural Parishes

The following buildings are Grade II listed, except where indicated otherwise:

Milepost 350 yards south of turn to Sleagill (A6 east side)
Milepost 325 yards north of turn to Sleddale A6 west side)
Milepost opposite Shap Granite works (A6 west side)
Church of St Michael
North entrance gates and piers to St Michael's Churchyard (Jackson's Lane)
Keld Farmhouse (Keld northwest side)
Barn/byre range adjoining to right of Keld Farmhouse
Cottage, barn and cart shed adjoining to left of Keld Farmhouse
Farmhouse opposite Keld Farm with attached hay loft (Keld south east side)
Barn/byre range adjoining farmhouse opposite Keld Farm
New Ing farmhouse (Main Street, Shap east side)
Coach house adjoining New Ing farmhouse
Forecourt wall, piers, railings and gate to New Ing farmhouse
Plane Trees and houses adjoining east end (Main Street, Shap east side)
Barn/Byres to north east of Plane Trees (Main Street, east side)
Lyndene (Main Street, east side)
Greyhound Hotel with milestone and mounting block (Main Street east side)
The Hermitage (Main Street west side)
Market Cross (Main Street west side) (Grade II*)
Cross Cottage and Cross Farmhouse with adjoining barn/byre range (Main Street west side)
Croft House (Main Street west side)
Milepost on roadside to east of Croft House (Main Street west side)
Green House with pavilions (Main Street west side)
Green Farmhouse with adjoining cottage, barn/byre range and area wall (Main Street off west side)
The Rockery, converted outbuildings adjoining and 2 the Rockery (Pow Lane south side)
Barn adjoining north end of the Rockery (Pow Lane south side)
Thornship House and byre adjoining south end (Thornship Lane west side)
Byre to north east of Thornship Farmhouse (Thornship Lane)
Barn to south of Thornship Farmhouse (Thornship Lane west side)
Keld Chapel
Lime-kiln to south east of Croft House, opposite entrance to Crag Lane (Shap rural)
Mary's Pillar on east side of road between Shap and Bampton Grange

Parish Crag Bridge over Swindale Beck
Shap Abbey Farmhouse with attached byre range
Wagon shed with hay loft to south east of Shap Abbey Farmhouse
Scullery Range to east of Shap Abbey Farmhouse
Hardendale Hall with adjoining byres and scullery
Wagon shed and byre to east of Hardendale Hall
Threshing barn and byre to north east of Hardendale Hall
Bridge over River Lowther (previously listed as Rosgill Bridge)
